

**FOREST ROW PARISH COUNCIL**  
**POLICY ON THE USE OF RECORDING EQUIPMENT, CAMERAS**  
**ETC AT MEETINGS (policy confirmed May 2016)**

Members of the public may photograph, record, tweet, blog or broadcast the proceedings of a meeting by the use of the relevant social/recording media in accordance with The Openness of Local Government Bodies Regulations 2014, amended s.1 of the 1960 Act. The Council will also record (audio/visual) meetings to create a definitive archive of meetings to preserve their integrity and accuracy. A separate area will be created for members of the public who do not wish to be filmed and their wishes will be respected.

Any Member of the Public who did not avail themselves of the opportunity to record meetings and wished to have access to the Council's recordings, would be able to make an appointment to visit the Council offices and view the recordings. A charge of £10 would be made for this.
