# COUNCILLORS' BRIEFING TO THE MEETING OF THE FACILITIES COMMITTEE DATED 10<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER 2024

- **1-4. FORMAL ITEMS.** As per usual. Members should please ensure that they have read the minutes of 25<sup>th</sup> June, which cross-reference with the notes below.
- 5. FINANCIAL REPORT. Apologies that this Committee's financial report is still presented under the old headings of 'Amenities' & 'Property'. Updating is a major task which also involves our accounts system providers, and we originally held off pending review of our committee structure. That appears not to have progressed, so perhaps for the next financial year we shall be able to update the codes.

In terms of current performance, income is running at a consolidated figure of 76.5% of income against budget, and 53.8% of expenditure against budget. For the property (hard asset) side that is 34.4% of income and 18.7% of expenditure, and for the amenities (soft asset) side it is (nominally) 96.7% of income and 95.5% of expenditure. However, the figures have been skewed by some accounting entries – eg under code 3189, where we were inadvertently invoiced twice and the refund had to be entered under that code.; also code 3136 where an adjustment needs to be made from the corresponding nominated reserve. [If members have any queries, it would be appreciated if hey could be received *before* the meeting, to allow for replies to be prepared.

- 6. CURRENT MATTERS ITEMS FOR STATUS REVIEW (†) / ITEMS FOR DECISION (\*)
  - 6.1 Gilham Bank grant application (†). An application for grant funding has been submitted to the Lund Fund, and a decision is awaited. (This is a renewed application, following a change of eligibility criteria).
  - 6.2 Streetlight repairs (\*). I have recently authorised a routine repair for column 65 in Medway Drive. Since then, I have been asked if we want to go ahead with the repairs to columns 69 (Post Horn Lane), 102 (Highgate Road) and 75 (Ashdown Close). I attach the UKPN quotes for the first two, the third can be done without UKPN involvement and will be appreciably less expensive. We do not really have a choice over these repairs.
  - 6.3 Queen's memorial bench (\*). This has now been delivered. Committee is requested to confirm exactly where it wants it located (if not already done).
  - 6.4 Park Crescent tree planting (†). There have been discussions with a resident over the choice and location of trees within the budget. He is willing to source, arrange for planting in November, and tend them thereafter. A copy of the proposed layout is attached.

- 6.5 Pothole repairs (\*). At the time of writing we have one detailed quote (attached) for repairs to the potholes on Council tarmac at Lewes Road (adj. Lantern House) and Ashdown Road. Other quotes are still awaited, unless Committee feels these are reasonable enough to proceed on.
- 6.6 A22 verge parking issues (\*). We have had a plethora of complaints about people (both residents & visitors) parking on the tarmac which crosses the Council-owned verges on the Lewes Road from Thai Time to Lantern House, to the extent that emergency vehicles have been unable to gain access. The residents have offered to put some substantial planters along the edges to prevent parking on the grass and have asked if we could instal some semi-permanent 'No Parking' signs.
- 6.7 Children's grave at the cemetery (†). The approval of Council has been referred back to Messrs Ballard & Shortall for implementation.
- 6.8 Community Centre refurbishment group (†). This has been constituted but it is understood has not yet started on its work.
- 6.9 Crittall window insulation quote (\*). We can now proceed to the next stage with the Crittall windows: saving on heat loss. Secondary glazing would be possible, but the internal design of our windows would make its construction very difficult, and it would require listed building consent. The alternative (suggested by the heritage building consultant) is thermal film over the glass, which will reduce heat loss by up to 40%. This has to be installed by a specialist contractor, and we have been quoted £6184 (ex VAT). (This would not preclude the installation of full-length curtains as well). Does Committee wish to proceed with this proposal? we have applied for a 50% grant from Wealden but not yet had a reply.
- 6.10 CCTV extensions (†). Our CCTV adviser has said that wirelessly linking a camera on Newlands Place to our main CCTV system would present major problems of consistent signal and power supply, and has proposed instead a solar powered mini-camera which could be accessible by smartphone: he is preparing a quote for this. As to a more public CCTV system, I reported the Clerk's Society legal advice to Council on 28<sup>th</sup> August. Does Committee wish to take this further for instance, with the business group?
  6.11 Gleeson Land (†). Further progress on this project depends significantly on the outcome of an ecological survey now being undertaken by Tom Forward, expected later this month.
- 6.12 Play equipment (\*). The original proposal voted for by Committee was for a wheelchair-accessible roundabout. Embarrassingly, our current roundabout turned out to

be the actual accessible version offered by the selected provider, and in good working condition. The provider's representative proposed in the alternative that our budget could be spent on replacing the current swing installation (which is not in prime condition), and including an accessible seat. We still await a quote for this. As for the games area, anecdotal feedback via our youth leader is that the combined basketball hoop and goal would be preferred.

- **6.13.** Playpark access path (\*). A detailed quote has been obtained (from the same company that quoted for pothole repair) and is attached. The same considerations apply. 6.14 Cemetery consultation (†). I have contacted Action in Rural Sussex with a draft of the content, and I am awaiting their quote for the work.
- 6.15 Village Green Plan (\*). I have a quote for a topographical plan of the Green £500 (ex VAT). An Ordnance Survey plan will be in the order of £25.
- 6.16 Discussions with the Village Club (†). Some preliminary discussions have taken place (under the auspices of the 'Festival Corner' working group). It is hoped a summary report will be available to this meeting.
